MTSS IN OSSU

Equitable Access to High-Quality, Standards-Aligned Core Instruction in Academics and SEL-B (K-12)

CORE INSTRUCTION

Academic, Behavioral and Social-Emotional Screening is conducted regularly with all students using technically adequate, efficient measures

UNIVERSAL SCREENING

SU-, Building-, Grade-level and Individual Problem-solving Teams continuously collaborate towards enhanced outcomes for all students

SHARED OWNERSHIP

Ongoing process of collecting and analyzing a continuum of data sources to inform instruction and intervention

DATA-BASED DECISIONS

Response to Intervention is an assessment process that informs instructional intensification and student growth within MTSS and an approach used for Specific Learning Disability (SLD) determination

RTI

Schools and Families work together collaboratively toward attainment of positive, strengths-based goals and outcomes

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

Equitable, effective, and efficient evidence-based supports and services are provided via a seamless system of service delivery

MULTIPLE LAYERS

Structures are established to support research-to-practice efforts that build capacity and result in sustainable practices and outcomes
